How To Use The Reproducible

1. Provide each student with copies of the reproducible.
2. First ask the students to read and punctuate each sentence. Then have them lightly color and cut out the feathers and the turkeys.
3. Ask that each student find a telling sentence to match each asking sentence. Discuss the results of this effort and talk about what your students learned.
4. Then have each student glue the telling sentences to the back of the telling-sentence turkey so that they resemble fanned tail feathers, and repeat the process with the asking-sentence turkey and his feathers.
